Congratulations! ... We appreciate your recent marble purchase with Ortega. Your marble will provide many years of beauty and usability. To maintain the shine and protection of your marble, **DO NOT USE** any **ABRASIVE** cleaners such as "SOFT SCRUB", powdered "COMET", or "AJAX".

The water in Lubbock and surrounding communities are known for harshness and deposits. We suggest you use a product called "Gel Gloss" at least once a month. We have Gel Gloss in stock for your convenience. This cleaner/polish leaves a wax finish which helps repel the water off walls and in bowls. If hard water and soap build up, you can use a multipurpose, no scratch, Teflon pad found in grocery stores. **DO NOT USE THE GREEN ONE! IT IS ABRASIVE ...**

When cleaning shower/tub walls **DO NOT** scrub or agitate the silicone seams. They should only be sprayed and wiped or rinsed off. When cleaning the textured floor of the shower pans, a soft bristled nylon brush can be used.

If you should ever get a calcium or rust stain on your Engineered Composites, you can use a small amount of CLR Cleaner to remove them. Please use this chemical in moderation, and make sure to clean it off as soon as you put it on. **DO NOT** allow it to sit on your marble.

Any type of foam cleaner will work well on Venetian Marble. Cleaners such as LYSOL, SCRUBBING BUBBLES, OR TILEX will disinfect and leave your marble with a beautiful shine! Also any cleaner approved for fiberglass or acrylic can be used. All cleaners have a toll free number on them.
